The Local Administration Act (Act No. 15 of 1930)

The Chinsali District Council (Fish Levy) By-laws, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections firty-two and fifty-nine of the Local Administration Act, 1980, the following By-laws are hereby made:

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Chinsuli District Title Council (Fish Levy) By-laws, 1990.

2. In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires-

- "area" means the area under the jurisdiction of the Council;
 - "check-point" means any place within the area designated by the Council for the weighing of fish by the officers or employees of the Council;

"collector "means any officer of the Council authorised to collect revenue for the Council;

"Council" means the Chinsali District Council;

"fish" means any dead vertebra fish and any part thereof whether or not preserved in any form.

3. Every person who sells fish within the area or exports fish from the area shall pay to the Council a fish levy at the rate of ten ngwee for every kilogram of dried fish and five ngweo for every kilogram of fresh fish.

4. No person shall sell or export from the area, any fish which has not been weighed at a check-point and in respect of which fish levy has not been paid.

5. Fish Levy shall become payable as soon as the fish has been weighed at check-point.

(2) Payment of fish levy in respect of any weight of fish shall be made at the check-point at which the fish is weighed and shall be received by a collector who shall immediately issue an official receipt for each such payment.

Offences and ponalties

6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of offence and shall be liable upon conviction—

- (a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding one hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months, or to both;
- (b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding two hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both
