## The Local Administration Act (Act No. 15 of 1980)

## The Gwembe District Council (Bird Levy) By-laws, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections fifty-two and fifty-nine of the Local Administration Act, 1980, the following By-laws are hereby made:

· 1. These By-laws may be cited as the Gwembe District Title Council (Bird Levy) By-laws, 1990.

- 2. In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires-
  - " area " means the area under the jurisdiction of the Council;
  - "bird " means any domesticated fowl, guinea fowl, turkey, goose, duck or any part thereof whether dead or alive;
  - "check-point" means any place within the area designated by the Council for the payment of bird levy;
  - " collector " means any officer of the Council authorised to collect revenue for the Council;
  - "Council" means the Gwembe District Council;
  - "movement permit" means a permit issued by a Veterinary Officer under the provisions of the Stock Diseases Regulations.

3. Every person who slaughters a bird within the area to sell the meat thereof, or exports a bird from the area, shall pay to the Council a bird levy of one kwacha per bird.

4. No person shall slaughter a bird in the area to sell the meat thereof or export from the area any bird for which no bird levy has been paid.

5. (1) Bird levy shall become payable as soon as the permit has been issued.

(2) Payment of bird levy in respect of any bird shall be made at the check-point and shall be received by a collector who shall immediately issue an official receipt for each such payment.

6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction—

- (a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding one hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both;
- (b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding two hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both.
