The Forests Act
(Laws, Volume VI, Cap. 311)

The Forest (Amendment) Regulations, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *sixty-eight* of the Forests Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Forest (Amendment) Regulations, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Forest Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 2 and the substitution therefor of the following regulation:

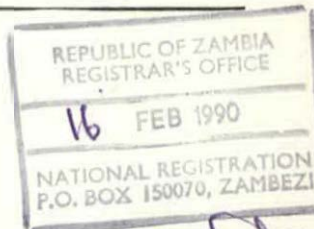
2. (1) The fees and prices to be paid to the Forest Department in respect of the felling or taking of indigenous forest produce and of other acts requiring a licence or receipt shall be those set out in Parts I and II of the First Schedule.

(2) The prices to be paid to the Forest Department in respect of honey and beeswax produced by that Department shall be those set out in Part III of the First Schedule.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is revoked and the First Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations is substituted therefor.
