The Roads and Road Traffic Act (Laws, Volumo XV, Cap. 766)

The Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section two hundred and fifty-eight of the Roads and Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991, and shall be read as one with the Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

- (2) These Regulations shall come into effect on the expiration of a period of thirty days after the date on which they are published in the Gazette.
- 2. The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 12 of the following new regulation:

Amendment principal Regulations

13. An owner of a vehicle which has been removed, arrangements have been made for its removal, by an incurred for authorised officer, shall pay the expenses incurred in removal and storing the vehicle as specified in the Schedule.
