## The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vehicles) Regulations, 1985, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

- (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 1991.
- 2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 3 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Revocation and replacement of regulation 3

3. The duties appearing in Chapter 87, in as far as they Exemption apply to motor vehicles imported in a completely knocked-of duty down condition in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations, are suspended to the rate of 5% an valorem:

Provided that the suspension of duty shall be granted only to such assemblers and manufacturers of motor vehicles as may be approved by the Controller.
