The Medical Aid Societies and Nursing Homes (Exemption, Establishment and Operation) (Authorisation Fees) Order, 1991

IN EXERCISE of powers contained in regulation 8 of the Medical Aid Societies and Nursing Homes (Exemption, Establishment and Operation) Regulations, 1990, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Medical Aid Societies and Nursing Homes (Exemption, Establishment and Operation) (Authorisation Fees) Order, 1990.

2. A person or organisation exempted or permitted to operate or establish a nursing home under regulation 3 of the Regulations shall be issued with a certificate of Authority on payment of—

- (a) an inspection fee of—
 - (i) K30,000, or K20,000 for a private nursing home according to its hed capacity;
 - (ii) K40,000, or K20.000 for a private hospital according to its bed capacity, and

(b) a registration fee of—

- (i) K15,000 for a private nursing home;
- (ii) K25,000 for a private hospital:

Provided that where a private nursing home is situated in a rural area, the person or organisation shall pay twenty-five percent of the fees chargeable under this Order.
