STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 37 OF 1991

The Control of Goods Act
(Laws, Volume XIII, Cap. 610)

The Control of Goods (Import Licence Fees) (Exemption)
(No. 2) Notice, 1991

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *three A* of the Control of Goods Act, the following Notice is hereby issued.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Control of Goods (Import Licence Fees) (Exemption) (No. 2) Notice, 1991. Title

2. The companies and organisations specified in the Schedule to this Notice shall be exempt from the payment of import licence fees under section *three A* of the Act at the rate of 5 per cent in respect of the goods specified in the Schedule. Exemption from import licence fee

3. The goods in respect of which exemption has been granted under paragraph 2 shall not be sold or disposed of to any person, organisation or agency not entitled to that exemption except with the written consent of the Minister and upon payment of the import licence fees in respect of those goods at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal. Exempted goods not to be sold without permission
