The Chiefs (Recognition) (No. 4) Order, 1991

WHEREAS the President is satisfied that the person named in the Schedule to this Order is entitled to hold the office specified in that Schedule as required by subsection (2) of section *three* of the Chiefs Act:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in section *three* of the Chiefs Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Chiefs (Recognition) (No. 4) Order, 1991.

2. The person named in the Schedule to this Order is hereby recognised as being, within the area in Zambia described in the Schedule, the holder of the office specified in that Schedule.
