The Roads and Road Traffic Act (Laws, Volume XV, Cap 766)

The Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1992

In EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections two hundred and sixteen and two hundred and fifty-eight of the Roads and Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Roads and Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

Title and commencement

- (2) These Regulations shall come into effect on the expiration of a period of thirty days after the date on which they are published in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 12 of the following new regulation:

Amendment of principal Regulations

13. An owner of a vehicle which has been removed, or arrangements have been made for its removal, by an authorised officer, shall pay the expenses incurred in storing the vehicle as specified in the Schedule.

Expenses incurred for removal and storage

3. The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion of the Schedule set out in the appendix to these Regulations.
