## The Inland Waters Shipping (Survey and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992

In EXERCISE of the powers contained in section twenty-four of the Inland Waters Shipping Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Inland Waters Shipping (Survey and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Inland Waters (Survey and Registration) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the First Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto is substituted therefor.
