The Mumbwa District Council (Fish Levy)
(Amendment) By-laws, 1993

In exercise of the powers contained in section seventy-six of the Local Government Act, 1991, the following By-laws are hereby made:

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Mumbwa District Council (Fish Levy) (Amendment) By-laws, 1993 and shall be read as one with the Mumbwa District Council (Fish Levy) By-laws, 1982, in these By-laws referred to as the principal By-laws.

Title

S.I. No. 89 of 1982

2. The principal By-laws are amended by the revocation of by-law 3 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Revocation and replacement of by-law 3

3. Every person who sells fish within the area or exports fish from the area shall pay to the Council a fish levy at the rate of twenty Kwacha for every kilogram of dried fish and ten Kwacha for every kilogram of fresh fish.

Imposition of fish levy

3. The principal By-laws are amended by the revocation of by-law 6 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Revocation and replacement of by-law 6 Offences and penalties

- 6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction—
  - (a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding one thousand Kwacha or imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both; or
  - (b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine of two hundred Kwacha for every day during which the contravention continues or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both.
