## The Customs and Excise Act (Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)

## The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Component Parts and Materials for Vghicles) Regulations, 1985, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 3 and the substitution therefor of the following:

3. The duties appearing in the Customs Tariff set out in the First Schedule to the Act, in so far as they apply to the goods covered by Heading Nos. 87.01, 87.02, 87.04, 87.05, and 87.06 are suspended to ten per centum advalorem and those covered by Heading 87.03 to twenty per centum advalorem in respect of motor vehicles imported in a completely knocked down condition within the meaning of that expression in these Regulations:

Provided that the suspension of duty shall be granted only to such assemblers and manufacturers of motor vehicles as may be approved by the Controller.
