**Declaration of State of Public Emergency**

WHEREAS it is provided under Article 30 of the Constitution of Zambia that the President may in consultation with Cabinet at any time by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* declare that a state of Public Emergency exists;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I FREDERICK JACOB TITUS CHILUBA, President of the Republic of Zambia, do hereby declare that a state of Public Emergency exists.
