## The Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1994

In exzercise of the powers contained in section fifty-eight of the Firearms Act, the following Regulations are hercby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fircarms (Amendment) Regulations, 1994, and shall be read as one with the Firearms Regulations, herein referred to as the principal Regulations.
(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th January, 1994.
2. The principal Regulations are amended by the repeal of the First Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.

## Certificates, Licence or Permit

1. Tourist's import permit
2. Certificate of exemption Fees K
3. Fircarms licence:
(a) in respect of each rifle or pistol entered on licence 20,000
(b) in respect of each breech-loading firearm other than a rifle or pistol 15.000
(c) in respect of each muzzle-loading firearm $\quad 10,000$
4. Duplicate firearm licence 5.000
5. Certificate of exemption (antique firearm) 5,000
6. Firearm dealer's licence 100,000
7. Permit for repair, test or proof 5,000)
8. Where a further firearm is entered on a firearm licence under subsection (8) of section thirteen, the fee payable in respect of that firearm shall be one half of the fee prescribed therefor under item (3) of this Schedule for each year or part of a year for which the firearm lieence continues to be in force.
