The Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1994

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *fifty-eight* of the Firearms Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Regulations, 1994, and shall be read as one with the Firearms Regulations, herein referred to as the principal Regulations.
