# The Fisheries (Fishing Licence Fees) Regulations, 1994

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section twenty-one of the Fisheries Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Fishing Title Licence Fees) Regulations, 1994.

2. A person shall, in respect of a Special Fishing Licence, pay a fee as set out in the First Schedule.

Special fishing licence fee

3. A person shall, in respect of a fishing licence issued for the purpose of fishing in a commercial fishing area, pay a fee as set out in the Second Schedule, for each fishing boat.

Licence for commercial fishing area

4. Where the Minister considers it desirable in the interest of developing the fish industry, he may remitor reduce by such amount as he considers fit, any of the fees required to be paid under these Regulations in respect of a person obtaining a licence for the first time.

Remission or reduction

5. The Fisheries (Fishing Licence Fees) Regulations, 1991, are hereby revoked.
