The Workmen's Compensation Act (Laws, Volume X, Cap. 509)

The Workmen's Compensation (Assessment of Earnings) Regulations, 1994

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section one hundred and twenty-five as read with subsection (5) of section one hundred and seven of the Workmen's Compensation Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Assessment of Earnings) Regulations, 1994.

Title

2. The Commissioner shall not assess an employer for any earnings in excess of K600,000 per annum of any workman in respectof the period to which the statement submitted under section one hundred and six relates.

Earnings in excess of K600,000

- 3. The earnings for assessment purposes shall include—
- Earnings for assessment

- (b) overtime payments:
- (c) shift differential payment;
- (d) leave pay if not included in (a) above;
- (e) payments made to casual workers employed in connection with employers nature of business;

(a) workmen's annual basic wages or salary up to K600,000;

- (f) add 12.5 per cent to total of items (a) to (e) to cover food and quarters.
- 4. The Workmen's Compensation (Assessment of Earnings) Regulations, 1992 are hereby revoked.
