The Tourism Act
(Act No. 29 of 1979)

The Tourism (Amendment) Regulations, 1994

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-eight* of the Tourism Act, 1979, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tourism (Amendment) Regulations, 1994, and shall be read as one with the Tourism Regulations, 1980, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 2 and the substitution therefor of the following Regulation:

2. (1) The fees set out in the First Schedule shall apply.

Fees

(2) The fees for the items 4, 5 and 6 of the Schedule may in the applicant's discretion be paid at the selling rate kwacha equivalent as at the date of lodging the application.

3. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of the First Schedule and the substitution therefor of the First Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.

PRESCRIBED FEES

1. A set of forms	K2,000
2. Investment Proposal Guidelines	K2,000
3. Appraising, processing and supervising a project and consultancy collectively	1 per cent of the total cost of the project
4. Authorisation to establish a hotel, a tour-operating business, a travel agency business, an air-charter business, a vehicle or vessel leasing business, a restaurant, cafe, a discotheque or a convention centre	US \$150
5. Licence to operate a tourist enterprise	US \$100
6. Renewal of a tourist enterprise licence (excluding a hotel licence)	US \$300
