## The Zambia Defence Force (United Nations Peace Keeping Operations in Mozambique) (Emoluments) Regulations, 1994

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *twelve* and *two* hundred and ten of the Defence Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Zambia Defence Force (United Nations Peace Keeping Operations in Mozambique) (Emoluments) Regulations, 1994.

2. The money paid by the United Nations for the expenses incurred in sending each officer or soldier of the Zambia Defence Force to the United Nations Peace Keeping Operations in Mozambique shall be dispensed as follows:

- (a) fifty per centum of the total amount allocated to each officer or soldier to the officer or soldier; and
- (b) the other fifty per centum of the total amount allocated to each officer or soldier, to the Government.
