The Roads and Road Traffic Act (Laws, Volume XV, Cap. 766)

The Roads and Road Traffic (Construction, Equipment and Use) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *two hundred and fifty-eight* of the Roads and Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Road Traffic (Construction, Equipment and Use) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995, and shall be read as one with the Roads and Road Traffic (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the expiration of a period of thirty days after the date on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 19, of the following new regulation:

19A, (1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), no person shall import a left-handed driven vehicle into Zambia.

(2) No person shall drive a left-handed driven vehicle on Zambian roads, except where the vehicle—

- (i) was already in the country on the 1st of February, 1995;
- (ii) is in transit or is temporarily imported into the country pending export; or
- (iii) is donated to the Government or a government agency.

Insertion of regulation 19A Left-handed driven vehicles prohibited
