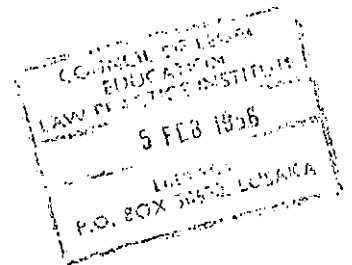

The Chiefs (Withdrawal of Recognition) Order, 1996
