Regulations, the Speaker of the National Assembly has informed the President and the Electoral Commission of the vacancies that have occurred in the elected membership of the National Assembly in respect of Mumbe»hi, Petauke and Zambe»i East Constituencies, all by reason of death;

Now thererore, inexercise of the powers contained in regulation 8 of the said regulations the following Order is hercby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the National Assembly ByElections (Mumbezhi Constitucncy No. 09, Pctauke Constituency No. 055 and Zambe7i. East Constituency No. 113) (Election Dates and Times of Poll) Order, 1997.
2. Nominations for elections in the Constituencies referred to in paragraph 1 may be lodged with the Returning Officers on Nominations for elections Thursday 8th May, 1997 between 0900 hours and 1500 hours.
3. The poll in the Constituencies referred to in Paragraph 1 shall be Laken on Wednesday 28ıh May, 1997 between 0600 hours and 1700 hours:

Provided that no such poll shall be taken in the Constituency where only one candidate has been validly nominated for the election.
