# The Control of Goods Act (Laws, Volume 23, Cap. 421)

# The Control of Goods (Import Declaration Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 1998

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *three* A of the Control of Goods Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Import Declaration Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 1998, and shall be read as one with the Control of Goods (Import Declaration Fee) Regulations, 1997, in these Regulations, referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion—

(a) of the definition of the word "import" and the substitution therefor of the following:

> " import " shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in the Customs and Excise Act; " and

- (b) of the definition of the word "importer" and the substitution therefor of the following:
  - "importer" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in the Customs and Excise Act;"

3. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (2)—

- (a) by the deletion of the word "or " at the end of paragraph(c);
- (b) by the insertion after paragraph (c) of the following new paragraph;
