The Energy Regulation (Licensing) Regulations, 1998

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *nine* and *ten* of the Energy Regulation Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Energy Regulation (Licensing) Regulations, 1998.

2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires, "application," means an application for a licence persuant to section *nine* of the Act.

3. (1) An application for a licence to operate an undertaking For shall be in the form set out in Part I of the First Schedule and shall approximation approximately appro

(2) An application form under these Regulations-

- (a) shall be submitted to the Board in triplicate;
- (b) shall be accompanied by the application fee as set out in the Second Schedule; and
- (c) shall be accompanied by the documents and particulars specified in Part II of the First Schedule.

4. The Board may require, from any person who has lodged an application for a licence under these Regulations, such further information as it considers necessary.

5. The Gazette notice to be published by the Board in accordance with subsection (4) of section *nine* shall, in addition to the matters specified in that subsection—

(a) specify the full names of the current directors of the applicant identifying their residential addresses, nationality and other affiliations and background including
