Regulation 88 of the principal Regulations is amended—</p> <p>(a) in paragraph (c)—</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(i) by the deletion of the figure “ 1000 ” and the substitution therefor of the figure “ 5000 ”; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(ii) by the insertion of the word “ and ” immediately after the semi-colon; and</p> <p>(b) by the insertion immediately after paragraph (c) of the following new paragraph:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(d) for the electronic processing of customs computerisation, the sum of ten fee units shall be paid at the time of lodgement of the entry.</p> | <p>Amendment<br/>of regulation<br/>88</p> |
