The Subordinate Courts (Limits of Jurisdiction of Subordinate Courts Presided over by Resident Magistrates) (Amendment) Rules, 2000

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *four* and *fifty-seven* of the Subordinate Courts Act, the following Rules are hereby made:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Subordinate Courts (Limits of Jurisdiction of Subordinate Courts Presided over by Resident Magistrates) (Amendment) Rules, 2000, and shall be read as one with the Subordinate Courts (Limits of the Jurisdiction of Subordinate Courts Presided over by Resident Magistrates) Rules, in these Rules referred to as the principal Rules.

2. The principal Rules are amended by the deletion of Rule 9 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Amendment of Rule 9

(9) The Subordinate Court Presided over by the Resident Magistrate, Chipata.

Within all Districts within the Eastern Province, the Central Province and the Northern Province."
