The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act (Laws, Volume 20, Cap. 366)

The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2000

In EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-seven* of the Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2000.

Title

2. The functions of the Minister under the Act, in so far as they relate to the Agreement described in the Schedule to this Order, and all other documents connected to the Agreement are hereby delegated to Dunstan Weston Kamana who is a public officer in the Service of the Government of the Republic of Zambia, and who is at present serving as Ambassador at the Embassy of Zambia to the United States of America and is stationed in Washington D. C.

Delegation of functions

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

The Development Credit Agreement between the International Development Association (as Lenders) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Borrowers) for the Public Service Capacity Building project (PSCAP) for amounts in various currencies equivalent to Twenty Million Four Hundred Thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 20.400.000.00).
