**The Customs and Excise (Excise Duty) (Suspension)
Regulations, 2000**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Excise Duty) (Suspension) Regulations, 2000.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st February, 2000.

2. (1) The excise duty on electrical energy as set out in the Schedule to these Regulations is suspended to the extent shown in the Schedule when consumed by the Companies set out in the Schedule.

(2) The period of suspension is twenty years from the date of commencement of these Regulations.
