**The Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship
Training (Registration of Institutions) (Fees) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2001**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-six* of the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Act, 1998 and after consultation with the Technical, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Authority, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training (Registration of Institutions) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001, and shall be read as one with the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training (Registration of Institutions) (Fees) Regulations, 1999, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

TYPE OF INSTITUTION	FEES UP TO 4 TRAINING PROGRAMMES	FEES FOR EACH ADDITIONAL PROGRAMME
(a) Colleges offering qualifications up to Diploma Level	2,778 fee units per year	833 fee units for each additional programme per year
(b) Colleges offering qualifications up to Technician Level	2,222 fee units per year	833 fee units for each additional programme per year
(c) Colleges (Trades Training Institutes) offering qualifications up to Craft Level	1,667 fee units per year	833 fee units for each Additional programme per year
(d) Colleges offering Short Courses	1,667 fee units per year	833 fee units for each additional short course per year
(e) Vocational Skills Training Centre offering qualifications up to Trade Test Certificates	1,111 fee units per year	278 fee units for each additional programme per year
