## The Water Supply and Sanitation (Licencing of Utilities and Service Providers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003

In EXERCISE, of the powers contained in sections *twelve* and *thirty nine* of the Water Supply and Sanitation Act, 1997, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply and Sanitation (Licencing of Utilities and Service Providers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003 and shall be read as one with the Water Supply and Sanitation (Licencing of Utilities and Service Providers) Regulations, 2000, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion of subregulation (2) and the substitution therefor of the following subregulation:

Amendment of Regulation 4

(2) A licensee shall pay to the council a monthly licence fee of one percent of the licensee's total billing for the month:

Provided that a licensee who provides water and sanitation services on a non-commercial basis, that is the provision of water and sanitation to employees without directly charging for it, shall pay to the council a monthly licence fee as set out in Part 2 of the Second Schedule.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion of Part 2 and the substitution therefor of the Part 2 set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.
