The Kaputa District Council (Fish Levy) (Amendment) By-laws, 2003

In exercise of the powers contained in sections sixty-nine and seventy-six of the Local Government Act, the following By-laws are hereby made:

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kaputa District Council (Fish Levy) (Amendment) By-laws, 2003 and shall be read as one with the Kaputa District Council (Fish Levy) By-laws, 1982, in these By-laws referred to as the principal By-laws.

2. The principal By-laws are amended by the revocation of By-law 3 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Revocation and replacement of Bylaw 3

3. Any person who sells fish within the area or exports fish from the area shall pay to the Council a fish levy at the following rates:

Imposition of fish levy

(a) two hundred and fifty kwacha for one kilogram of dry fish; or

(b) two hundred kwacha for one kilogram of fresh fish.

4. The principal By-laws are amended by the revocation of By-law 6 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Revocation and replacement of Bylaw 6

6. (1) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws commits an offence and is liable, upon conviction:

(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding eighty penalty units or imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both; and

Offences and penalties
