The Local Government Act (Laws, Volume 16, Cap. 281)

The Local Government (Appointment of Local Government Administrator) (Nchelenge District Council) (Revocation) Order, 2003

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty -eighty* of the Local Government Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Appointment of Local Government Administrator) (Nchelenge District Council) (Revocation) Order, 2003.

2. The person named in the Schedule to this Order, being a public officer and who was appointed Local Government Administrator by the Local Government (Appointment of Local Government Administrator) (Nchelenge District Council) Order, 2002, shall cease to be Local Government Administrator for the Nchelenge District Council from the date of publication of this Order.

3. The suspension of the Councillors of the Nchelenge District Council which was effected by the Local Government (Appointment of Local Government Administrator) (Nchelenge District Council) Order, 2002, shall stand revoked from the date of publication of this Order.

4. The person named in the Schedule to this Order shall, from the date of publication of this Order, cease to discharge the functions of the Nchelenge District Council and such functions shall, with effect from that date, be vested in, and discharged by the Council.

5. The Local Government (Appointment of Local Government Administrator)(Nchelenge District Council) Order, 2002 is hereby revoked.
