The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2003

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section twenty-seven of the Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act, the following Order is hereby made:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Loans and Guarantees Title (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2003.
- The functions of the Minister under the Act, in so far as they Delegation of relate to the Agreements described in the Schedule to this Order, and all other documents connected to the Agreements, are hereby delegated to Dr. Inonge Mbikusita Lewanika who is a public officer in the service of the Government of the Republic of Zambia, and who is at present serving as Ambassador at the Embassy of Zambia to the United States of America and is stationed in Washington D.C.

AGREEMENTS

- (1) The Development Credit Agreement between the International Development Association (as Lenders) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Borrowers) for the Copperbelt Environment Project (CEP) for amounts in various currencies equivalent to Fourteen Million, One Hundred Thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 14,100,000).
- (2) The Development Grant Agreement between the International Development Association (as Donors) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Recipients) for the Copperbelt Environment Project (CEP) for amounts in various currencies equivalent to Fifteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 15,500,000)
