The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) (No.2) Order, 2004

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-seven* of the Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Loans and Guarantees Title (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) (No. 2) Order, 2004.

2. The functions of the Minister under the Act, in so far as such functions relate to the Agreement described in the Schedule to this Order, and all other documents connected to the Agreement, are hereby delegated to Dr Inonge Mbikusita-Lewanika who is a public officer in the service of the Government of the Republic of Zambia, and who is at present serving as Ambassador at the Embassy of Zambia to the United States of America and is stationed in Washington D.C.

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

AGREEMENT

The Development Credit Agreement between the International Dcvclopment Association (as Donor) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Recipient) for the Road Rehabilitation and Maintenance (ROADSIP II) Project for amounts in various currencies equivalent to thirty-three million five hundred thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 33,500,000).
