## The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2004

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *twenty-seven* of the Loans and Guarantee (Authorisation) Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Loans and Guarantees Title (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 2004.
