The Births and Deaths Registration Act
(Laws, Volume 5, Cap. 51)**The Births and Deaths Registration (General) (Amendment) Rules, 2004**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-one* of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the following Rules are hereby made:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (General) (Amendment) Rules, 2004, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration (General) Rules, in these Rules referred to as the principal Rules.
