#### The House of Chiefs (Amendment) Regulations, 2005

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Article 136 of the Constitution, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the House of Chiefs (Amendment) Regulations, 2005 and shall be read as one with the House of Chiefs Regulations, 1998, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 21 and the substitution therefor of the following:

21. The members shall be paid allowances as set out in the fifth Schedule

3. The principal Regulations are amended by the insertion after the Fourth Schedule of the new Fifth Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.
