**The Chiefs (Withdrawal of Recognition) Order, 2006**

WHEREAS the President is satisfied, after due inquiry, that the person named in the Schedule to this Order has ceased to be entitled under African Customary Law to hold office specified therein.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in section *four* of the Chiefs Act, the following Order is hereby made:
