The Electoral Act (Laws, Volume 2, Cap. 13)

The Electoral (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *seventeen* of the Electoral Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as Electoral (General) Amendment)Regulations, 2006 and shall be read as one with the Electoral (General) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of regulation 26A and the substitution therefor of the following regulation:

26A. Whenever a voter's card is lost, destroyed or is so defaced as to be illegible in any material particular, the voter concerned shall obtain a police report and present themself to the district registration officer in the area where the voter registered and the district registration officer shall issue a replacement card provided by the Commission.
