The Local Government Act (Laws, Volume 16, Cap. 281)

The Local Government (Street Vending and Nuisances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2007

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-four* of the Local Government Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Government Title (Street Vending and Nuisances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2007, and shall be read as one with the Local Government (Street S.I. No. 134 Vending and Nuisances) Regulations, 1992, in these Regulations of 1992 referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of the First Schedule and the substitution therefor of the First Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.
