1. These By-Laws may be cited as the The Nyimba District Council (Bird Levy) By-Laws, 2010	Title		
2. In these By-Laws, unless the context otherwise requires-	Interpretation		
"area" means the area under jurisdiction of the Council;			
"bird" means the domesticated fowl, guinea fowl, turkey, goose, duck, pigeon or any part thereof, whether dead or alive;			
"checkpoint" means any place within the area designed by the Council for the payment of bird levy;			
"collector" means an officer or agent of the Council authorised to collect revenue for the Council;			
"Council" means the Nyimba District Council.			
3. A person who sells a bird within the area or exports a bird from the area shall pay to the Council a bird levy at the following rates:	Imposition of bird levy		
(a) one thousand kwacha per bird; and			
(b) two hundred and fifty kwacha per chick			
4. A person shall not sell within the area or export from the area any bird for which a bird levy has not been paid to the Council.	No sale or export of bird without payment of bird levy
