- (h) the operation, administration and management of the legal aid system;
- (i) the system of declaration of assets by judicial officers;

- (j) the practice of delivery by unanimous judgements by the Supreme Court of Zambia; and
- (k) any other matters related or incidental to the matters specified under paragraphs (a) to (i);
