The Public Service (Retirement Age) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *thirty-three* of the Public Service Pensions Act, and in consultation with the Board, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service (Retirement Age) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015 and shall be read as one with the Public Service (Retirement Age) Regulations, 2014, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the repeal of regulation 4 and the substitution therefor of the following:

Repeal and replacement of regulation 4

4. (1) Notwithstanding section *thirty-three* of the Act, and subject to sub-regulation (2), an officer shall retire on the sixtieth anniversary of the date of the officer's birth.

Age of retirement of officer

(2) An officer may, on giving twelve month's notice, and subject to the approval of the President, retire on attaining the age of fifty-five or sixty-five years.
