The Road Traffic Act, 2002

(Act No. 11 of 2002)

The Road Traffic (City of Ndola) (Prohibition of Traffic) Regulations, 2016

In EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 233 of the Road Traffic Act, 2002, and on the recommendation of the Agency, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (City of Ndola) (Prohibition of Traffic) Regulations, 2016, and shall come into operation on the expiration of a period of thirty days from the date on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

Title and commencement

- 2. (1) The vehicles specified in the first column of the Schedule are prohibited from using the roads in the City of Ndola except the roads specified in the second column of that Schedule.
- Prohibition of certain traffic on roads
- (2) A person who contravenes sub-regulation (1) commits an offence and is liable, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding one thousand penalty units or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months, or to both.
- 4. The Roads and Road Traffic (City of Ndola: Prohibition of Traffic) Regulations, 1975, are revoked.

Vehicle

Any motor vehicle or trailer used or constructed or adapted for use primarily for the carriage of petroleum products in bulk
