The Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) (Amendment) Order, 2020

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 2 of the Provincial and District Boundaries Act, the following Order is made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) (Amendment) (No.) Order, 2020, and shall be read as one with the Provincial and District Boundaries (Division) Order, 1996, in this Order referred to as the principal Order.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is amended in the second column, by the deletion of the boundary descriptions of the Mungwi District and the Kasama District and the substitution therefor of the boundary descriptions set out in the Appendix.

Amendment of First Schedule

APPENDIX

(Paragraph 2)

Mungwi District

Starting at the confluence of the Chozi and Kalungu Rivers, the boundary runs down the Kalungu River to its confluence with the Chambeshi River; thence southwestwards along the Chambeshi River to its confluence with the Kambwititi Stream; thence up the Kambwititi Stream to its confluence with the Lukashya Stream; thence up the Lukashya Stream to its confluence with Mabula Stream; thence up the Mabula Stream to its confluence with Chansamina Stream; thence in a projected northwesterly direction for a distance of approximately 4 kilometres meeting the Mungwi Kasama Road (D18); thence

northwards for approximately 0.5 kilometres meeting the source of the Milima Stream; thence down the Milima Stream to the point where the Kasama Mbala Road, MI, crosses this river; thence along the Kasama Mbala Road, MI, for a distance of approximately 52 kilometres; thence northwestwards for a distance of approximately 4 kilometres to the source of an unnamed stream near Masabuka Munguluka Village; thence down this unnamed stream to its confluence with the Luombe River; thence up the Luombe River to its confluence with the Chilanga Stream; thence up this stream to its source; thence southeastwards for approximately 4 kilometres to the most westerly source of the Luela River; thence down the Luela River to its confluence with the Chambeshi River; thence up the Chambeshi River to its confluence with the Chalukila Stream; thence up the Chalukila Stream to its source; thence in south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 3 kilometres to the source of the Imabwe Stream; thence down the Imabwe Stream to its confluence with the Kabisha River; thence up the Kabisha River to its confluence with the lkuwa Stream; thence up the Ikuwa Stream to its source; thence northwestwards for a distance of approximately 2.5 kilometres to the source of the Ntumba River; thence down the Ntumba River to its confluence with the Chozi River; thence down Chozi River to its confluence with the Kalungu River, the point of starting.

KASAMA DISTRICT

Starting at the confluence of the Chambeshi and Lubambashi Rivers, the boundary runs up the Lubansenshi River to its confluence with the Fitaba River; thence up Fitaba River to its source; thence eastwards for approximately 2 kilometres along the southern base of Mpalapala Hills to the source of the Mayebwe Stream; thence down the Mayebwe Stream to its confluence with the Lubushi Stream; thence up the Lubushi Stream to its source; thence northwards for a distance of 2 kilometres to the source of Matipe Stream; thence up the Matipe Stream to its confluence with the Lubala River; thence up the Lubala River to its confluence with Lukulu River; thence up this river to its confluence with mwelekumbi River; thence the Mwelekumbi River to its east most source eastwards for a distance of approximately 7.5 kilometres to the source of the Kapobo Stream; thence down the Kapobo Stream to its confluence with the Kafubu River; thence down the Kafubu River to its confluence with the Luombe River; thence up the Luombe River to its confluence with the an unnamed Stream; thence up this unnamed stream to its source near Masabuka Munguluka Village; thence eastwards for a distance of approximately 4 kilometres to Kasama-Mbala Road; M1; thence southwards along the M1 Road to where it meets the Malima River; thence up this stream to its source; thence southwards for a distance of approximately 0.5 kilometres meeting the Kasama-Mungwi Road, D18; thence in a projected south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 4 kilometres to the confluence of Chansamina and Mabula Stream; thence down the Mabula Stream to its confluence with the Lukanshya Stream; thence down the Lukashya Stream to its confluence with the kambwititi Stream; thence down the kambwititi Stream to its confluence with the Chambeshi River; thence down the Chambeshi River to its confluence with the Lubansenshi River, the point of starting.
