The Customs and Excise Act (Laws, Volume 18, Cap. 322)

The Customs and Excise (Ports of Entry and Routes) (Amendment) Order, 2020

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 13 and 199 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Order is made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Ports of Entry and Routes) (Amendment) Order, 2020, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Ports of Entry and Routes) Order, 2003, in this Order referred to as the principal Order.

2. (1) The principal Order is amended by the insertion of the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph 9:

9A. (1) The goods specified in the Seventh Schedule shall only be exported through the customs ports and aerodromes set out in the Eighth Schedule.

(2) A person shall not, without the permission of the Commissioner-General, divert any of the goods specified in the Seventh Schedule to be exported through a customs port and aerodrome than the one set out in the Eighth Schedule.

(3) Goods exported through Victoria Falls port in accordance with this paragraph shall be transported by rail.

3. The hours for the transaction of business at customs houses shall—

(*a*) be from 08:00 hours to 13:00 hours and 14:00 hours to 17:00 hours on weekdays;

(b) despite paragraph (a)—

 (i) at Chanida, Kariba, Kasumbalesa, Katima Mililo, Kazungula and Mwami, business shall be transacted at all hours of the day, on all days including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays;

- (ii) at Kapiri-Mposhi and Livingstone, business shall be transacted from 08:30 hours to 13:00 hours and from 14:00 hours to 17:00 hours on weekdays and 08:30 hours to 13:00 hours on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays;
- (iii) at Chirundu, bills of entry may be received and business transacted all hours of the day and night on all days including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays;
- (iv) at Nakonde, bills of entry may be received at all hours of the day and night on all days including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays; and

(v) at Lusaka airport —

- (*aa*) bills of entry may be received on all weekdays including Saturdays from 08:00 hours to 13:00 hours; and
- (*bb*) business shall be transacted from 08:30 hours to 13:00 hours and from 14:00 ours to 17:00 hours on weekdays and 08:30 hours to 13:00 hours on Saturday.

4. Paragraph 12 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of the word "Seventh" and the substitution therefor of the word "Ninth".

5. Paragraph 13 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of the word "Eighth" and the substitution therefor of the word "Tenth".

6. The Seventh Schedule to the principal Order is amended in the heading by the deletion of the word "Seventh" and the substitution therefor of the word "Ninth".

7. The Eighth Schedule to the principal Order is amended in the heading by the deletion of the word "Eighth" and the substitution therefor of the word "Tenth".

8. The principal Order is amended by the insertion of the Schedules set out in the Appendices.
