**The Customs and Excise(Suspension) (Fuel) Regulations,
2020**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Fuel) Regulations, 2020. Title,
commencement
- (2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 14th January, 2020.
2. (1) The customs duty on petrol of heading 2710.12.10 and diesel of heading 2710.19.10 shall be suspended to zero percent where the oil marketing companies specified in the Schedule import the quantities of petrol or diesel for filling stations as specified in the Schedule. Suspension
