The Control of Goods Act (Laws, Volume 23, Cap. 421)

The Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Forest Produce) (Authorisation of Importation) (Democratic Republic of Congo) Order, 2020

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in regulation 3 of the Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Forest Produce) Regulations, 2017, the following Order is made:

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Forest Produce) (Authorisation of Importation) (Democratic Republic of Congo) Order, 2020.

(2) This Order is deemed to have come into operation on 28th June, 2020.

2. (1) The importation of the consignment of goods specified in the Schedule and originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo is authorised for purposes of transiting through Zambia.

(2) The consignment of goods specified in the Schedule shall be imported into, and transit through, Zambia until 28th June, 2021.

(3) The consignment under subparagraph (2) shall be inspected or examined by a person authorised under the Act and the importer or consignee shall pay 18,500 fee units in respect of each inspection or examination of the consignment.

3. The Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Forest Produce) (Prohibition of Importation) Order, 2017, does not apply to the consignment of goods specified in the Schedule.
