The Customs and Excise Act (Laws, Volume 18, Cap 322)

The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Wheat) Regulations, 2021

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension)(Wheat) Regulations, 2021.

Title, commencement and revocation

- (2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 1st March, 2021, and shall stand revoked on 1st August, 2021.
- 2. The duty on wheat of heading 1001.19.00 is suspended to zero where the companies specified in that Schedule import the quantities specified in the Schedule.
