## The Tourism and Hospitality Act, 2015 (Act No. 13 of 2015)

## The Tourism and Hospitality (Licensing) (Temporary Disapplication of Renewal and Retention Fees) Regulations, 2022

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 80 of the Tourism and Hospitality Act, 2015, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Tourism and Hospitality (Licensing) (Temporary Disapplication of Renewal and Retention Fees) Regulations, 2022, and shall be read as one with the Tourism and Hospitality (Licensing) Regulations, 2016, in these Regulations referred to as the temporarily disapplied Regulations.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 2022.

2. (1) The fees for renewal of an application of a licence and annual retention set out in the Second Schedule of the temporarily disapplied Regulations shall not apply for a period of one year from 1st January, 2022 to 31st December, 2022.

(2) On the expiry of the period under subregulation (1), these Regulations shall stand revoked and the fees for renewal of an application of a licence and annual retention in the temporarily disapplied Regulations shall apply.
